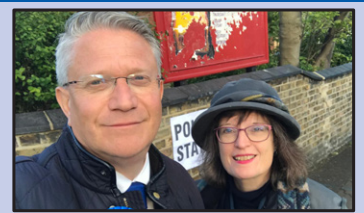

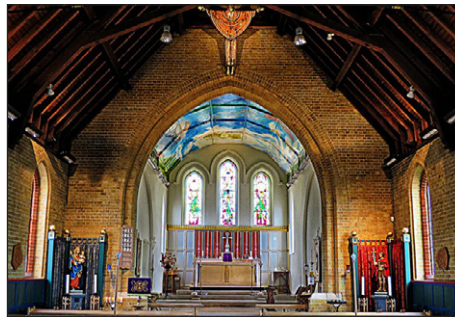


Conservative Councillor Campaigns

Councillor Judith Holt has been involved in a number of major campaigns within Havering, against cuts by the HRA Administration which likely will affect the most vulnerable in the community, often speaking out and asking questions in the Council Chamber. She joined other Conservative Councillors and our M.P. in the campaign to save the branch libraries in Gidea Park and Collier Row, plus she spoke against the changes to SEND Children's Transport. She drew attention to the lack of upkeep and tidiness of Upminster Cemetery and, owing to mistakes by the Administration, continues to fight for free-half-hour parking in Hornchurch, plus fairness for roads in Romford. She and the Conservative Group have voiced concerns about the Romford Masterplan, to build more high-rise blocks in Romford.

New Havering Local Heritage List Published

Most people know how interested Judith is in history and she was so pleased that seven of her nominations were accepted for the new list, including St. Alban Protomartyr Church, houses in Princes Road and Kings Road, plus Gidea Park Preparatory School, where she taught.
