ROMFORD POPULATION TO INCREASE BY 25,000*

25,000 new residents for Romford!

The Romford Masterplan, unveiled by the Havering Resident's Association,

has identified central Romford as the location for new homes, which would mean up to an additional 25,000 residents by 2040. This plan was rejected by the Conservatives when we were in charge of the **Town Hall.** This plan is unsuitable for Romford and fails to recognise the character of our historic market town. The RUSSC Club and Rotunda in Mawney Road are both sites designated for future development, along with tower blocks to be built on the Brewery Car park and Matalan in North Street. Your Conservative Councillors, Cllr. Nisha Patel, Cllr. David Taylor and Andrew Rosindell M.P. strongly object to these plans. Nisha have presented a proposal, to




